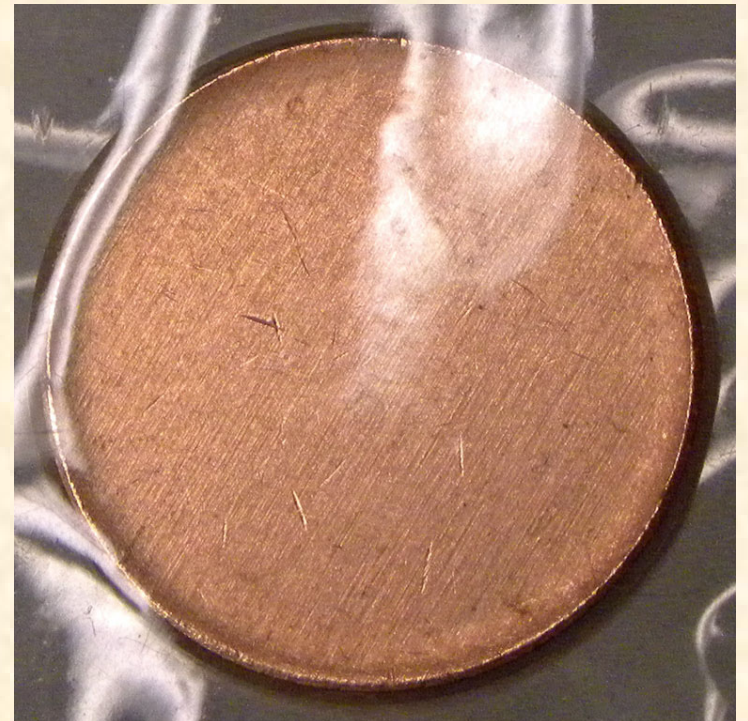


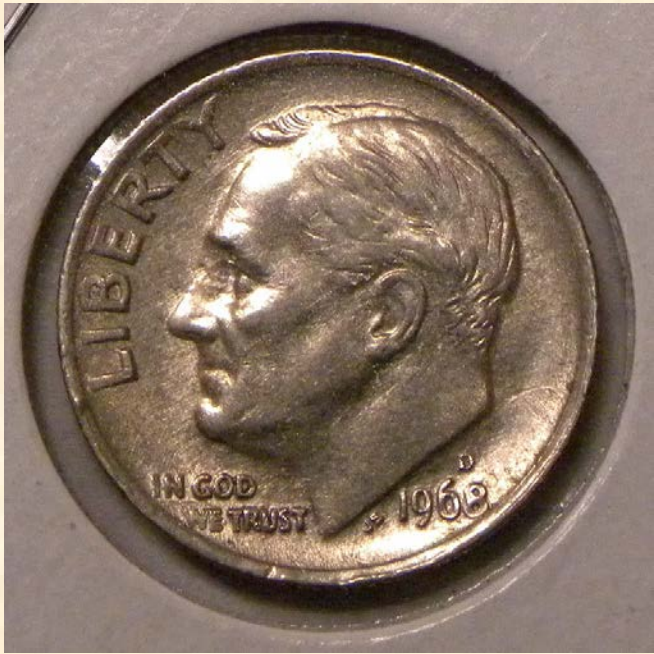

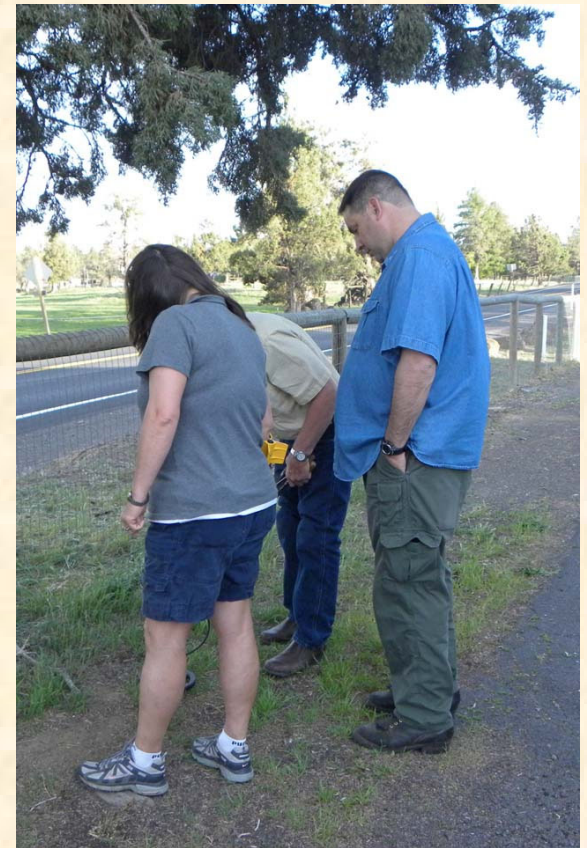

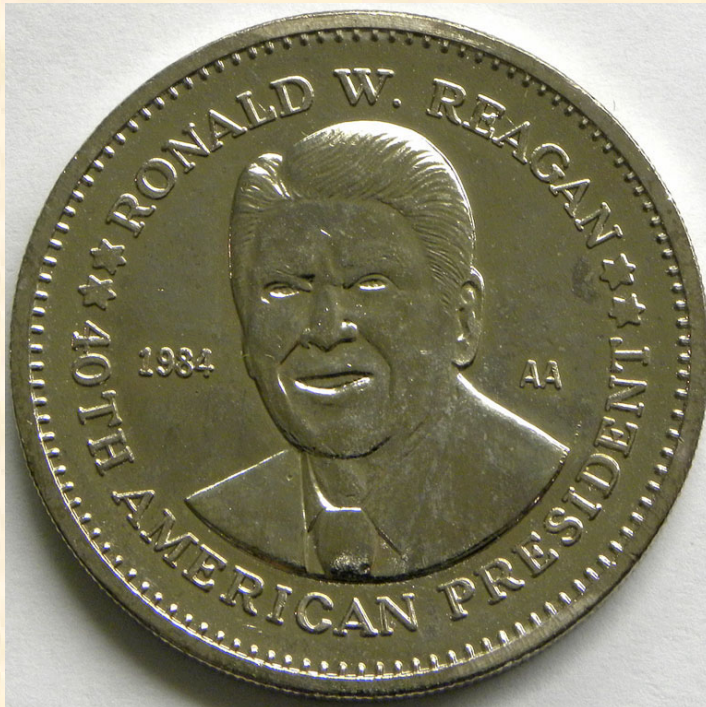


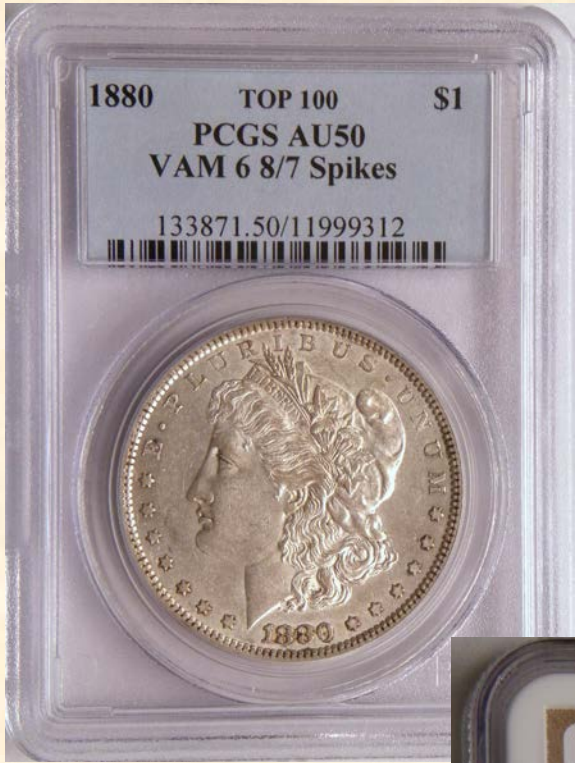

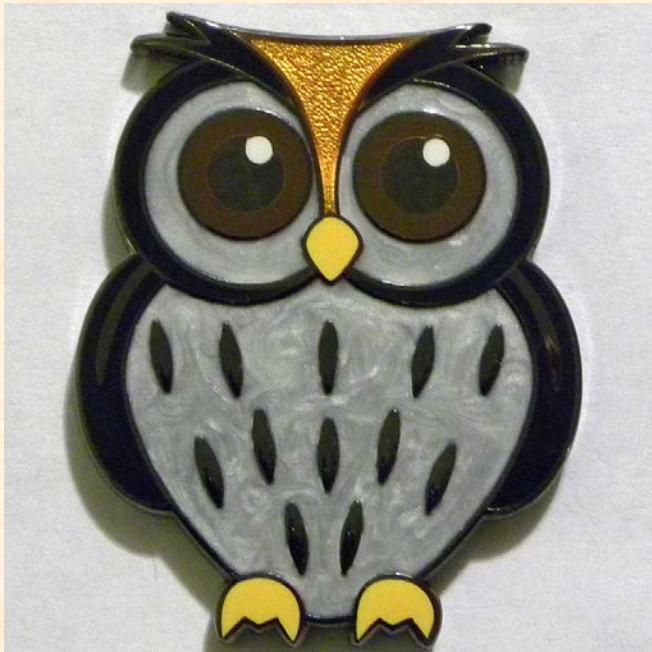

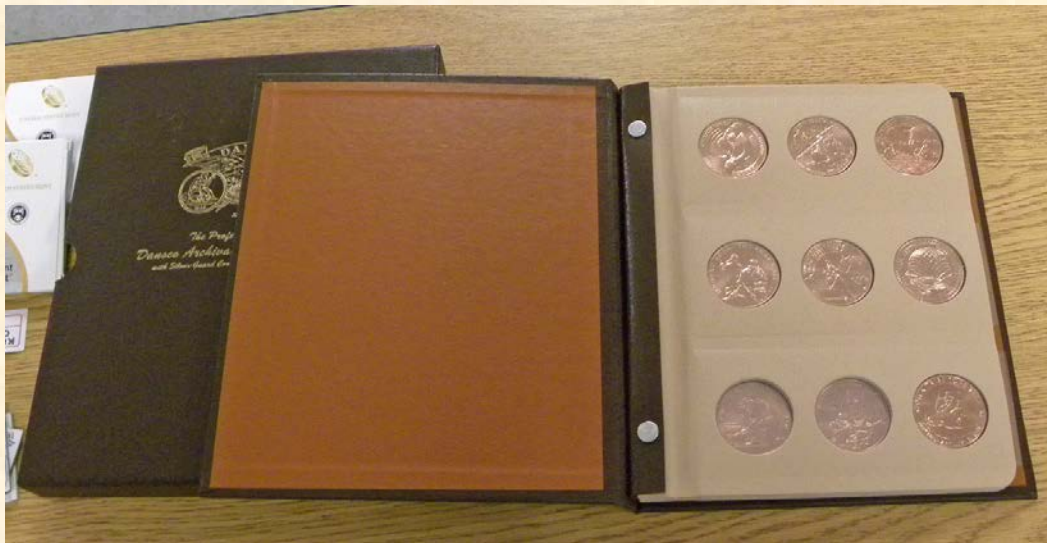

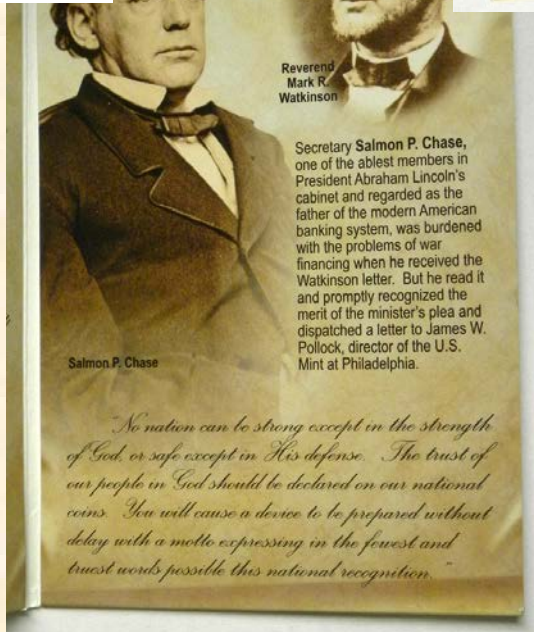

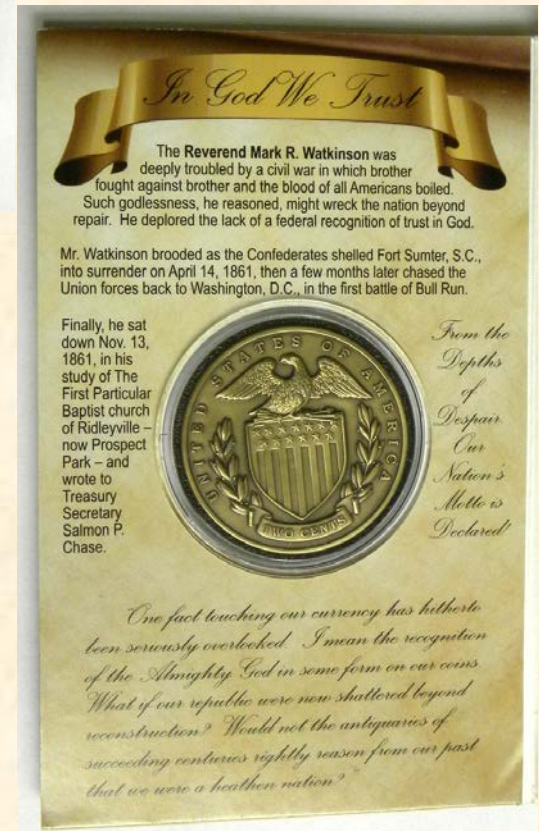

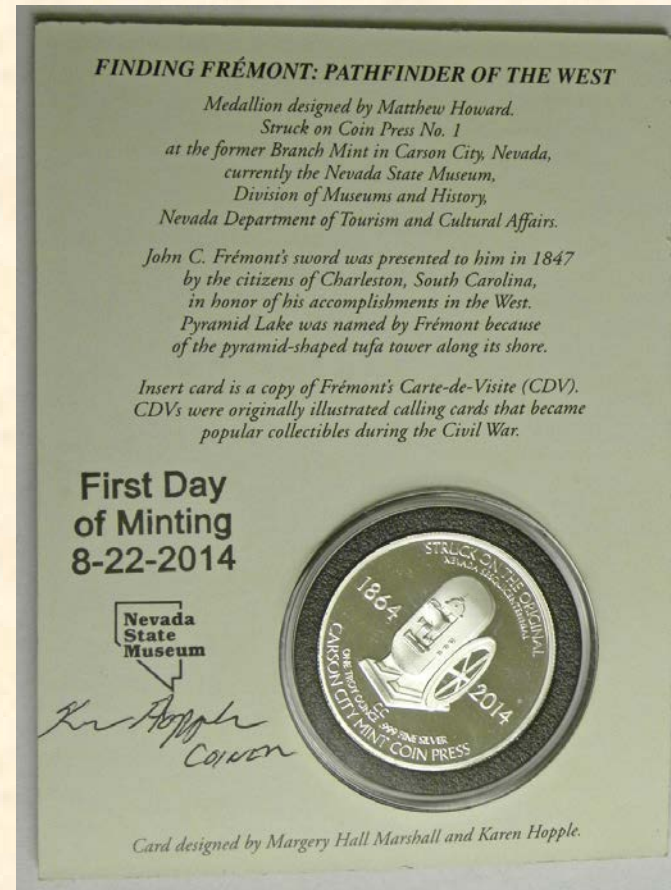
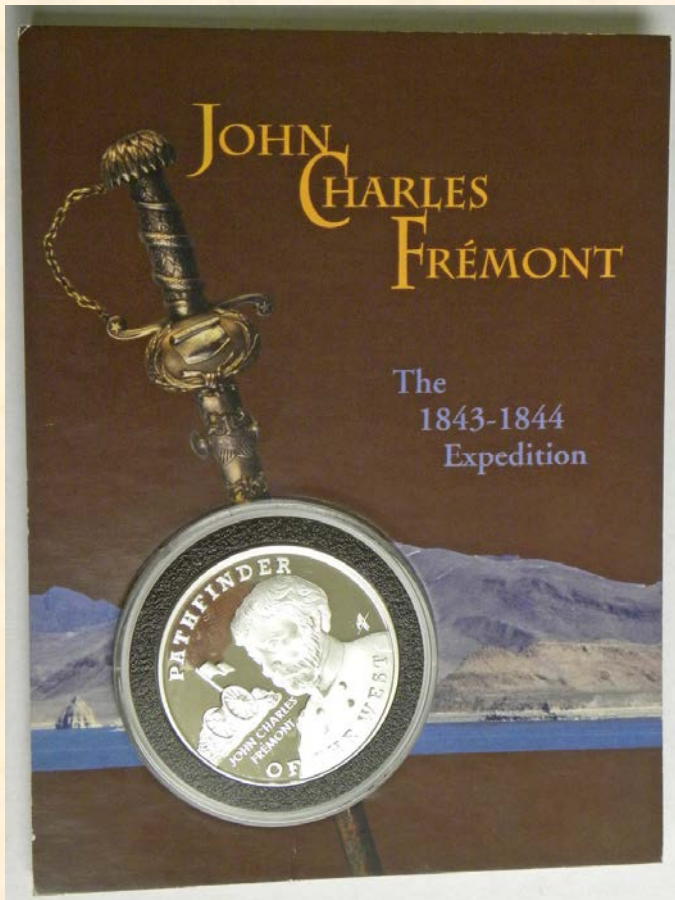
L.L.L.L. (Loyal Legion of Loggers and Lumbermen) pin depicting early World War I biplane.
